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INDEPENDENT LIVING

For the senior adult with an active lifestyle that lives independently, **Wesley Townhomes** and **Asbury Apartments** are great options. Residents pay an entry fee and down the road, once they are no longer living in the home, it is resold and 80% of the original entry fee is returned to the resident or their estate. Our apartments offer an independent lifestyle in a modern two story apartment building. They are rented on a month to month basis with no long term lease or entry fee are required. Both options include dining in our private dining room, laundry hookups, major appliances, all lawncare, maintenance and housekeeping services and a variety of activities.

TRINITY ASSISTED LIVING

For the independent senior adult requiring nursing care, medication administration or medical oversight, Trinity Assisted Living is a great option. Each private apartment has medical care, around the clock staffing and includes all laundry, housekeeping and maintenance. Each apartment has a kitchenette, large closet and large bathroom. Assisted living requires no lease or purchase and is on a month to month basis. There is an exclusive full service dining room as well as a variety of activities.
